Our vibrant arts scene supports local jobs and puts food on the table for local families. It attracts tourists who spend money on local businesses when they travel to attend arts events and visit cultural attractions.

This figure represents total annual spending by fifty participating organizations in 2016, plus spending in the community by audiences when attending arts and sciences events and venues





#### **COMPARISON FROM 2012 STUDY**

- Total Annual Impact: \$73 mill (2012) to \$90 mill (2017)
- Audience Spending: \$35.2 mill (2012) to \$38.1 mill (2017)
- Per Person Tourist Spending: \$54.78 (2012) to \$86.87 (2017)
- Jobs Supported: 2,497 FTE (2012) to 3,305 FTE (2017)
- Local Tax Revenue: \$3.8 million (2012) to \$4.6 million (2017)
- Resident Household Income: \$55.7 mill (2012) to \$67.7 mill (2017)
